O Ron Crozier from Twin City Mission-wonderful presentation on the mission of their shelters. We cannot fix homelessness. It is a human issue which needs to be treated with kindness and respect. People who are homeless are not any less human than the rest of us and should not feel like they are invisible. Homelessness doesn't define WHO you are, it just defines WHERE you are. Ron discussed the 4 C's- having the Courage to make the Choice to take the Chance to be the Change. TCM's goal is to empower the people that go through their shelter and programs by telling them (and us) don't be afraid to get dirty and own your dirt because when you do, success always follows. Ron always talked

about their 4 W's- How much do you **W**ant it? You've got to **W**ish for it. You've got to **W**ork for it and then you will **W**in it.
